## NEBRASKA DELAYED DEPOSIT SERVICES LICENSING ACT

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING LEGISLATIVE CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2019**

On April 19, 2018, Nebraska Governor Pete Ricketts approved Legislative Bill 194 ("L.B. 194") which was passed by the Nebraska Unicameral on April 18, 2018. L.B. 194 amended certain provisions of the Delayed Deposit Services Licensing Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 45-901 to 45-931 ("Act"), which will become effective on January 1, 2019.
